



Total Window Makeover Course Description

Objective: Introduce student to the tools, procedures and order of operations necessary to completely restore a basic wood double hung window in five days.

Day 1: Level 1 - Mechanical Makeover Part 1. Goal: Student will learn how to take a window apart and put it back together, as well as get an introduction to the table saw for making parting beads. Learn how to set up the window for quick assembly and disassembly. Learn how to board up a window

Day 2: Level 2 - Sash Makeover. Goal: Student will learn how to safely remove failing paint finishes, glazing compound and glass, make minor wood and epoxy repairs, address blemishes, use oil based primer to seal, protect and prepare the sash for painting, how to cut glass, bed it and top glaze.

Day 3: Level 2 - Frame Makeover. Goal: Student will learn how to safely remove failing paint finishes from the window frame jamb and exterior casings, make minor wood and epoxy repairs, use oil based primer to seal, protect and prepare the frame for painting.

Day 4. Level 3 - Sash Makeover, Frame Makeover. Goal: Student will learn how to prepare and apply finishes to a window jamb and casings and sash interior. Hardware restoration.

Day 5 Level 3 - Sash Makeover, Mechanical Makeover Part 2.. Goal: Student will learn how to apply a protective paint finish to the sash exterior and seal the glazing to the glass with paint. Learn how to assemble and tune a window for final assembly for completion.
